



EMIF Deliverable 15.4: First report on outreach activities: usage models and data sources characteristics

Executive summary

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Deliverable 15.4, "First report on outreach activities: usage models and data sources characteristics" details the work undertaken to identify, assess and implement potential stakeholders and relationships tangential to the European Medical Information Framework (EMIF).

To maximise the outreach efforts and ensure that these concentrate on those initiatives where a potential for collaboration is most likely, a process was established and reported in deliverable D15.2 ("Market Analysis: usage models and data sources characterization"). This generic collaboration workflow was developed by Synapse in the ADVANCE (IMI) project and consisted of five steps:

- Identification
- Assessment
- Prioritisation
- Implementation
- Monitoring
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To date EMIF has established identification and assessment of a large network of stakeholders with relevance to its goals internationally within the EU and the United States, with strategic prioritisation and implementation in a small number for mutual benefit. In this deliverable the process and identified stakeholders, with activity at time of reporting, are outlined and intended future activity indicated. For specific stakeholders with proposed interaction and activity, project fiches were developed by relationship leaders within EMIF, and are included in this deliverable (annexes I-IX).

Ultimately, EMIF seeks to both enrich its own data sources and capabilities, while enhancing the transference of knowledge, skills, experience and technologies with stakeholders identified who can benefit mutually with our common aims.
