Executive summary

Executive Summary

The main aim for this deliverable is to present the version 3.0 of the EMIF Catalogue, which was subject of a significant reengineering process regarding user interface, software architecture and service provisioning. Due to the increasing requirements, both internal and external, and to the agile development strategy defined from the beginning, the Catalogue is now based on the Community concept, which consists on independent workspaces joining users, databases, and tools related to a particular topic. Currently the catalogue integrates four of these groups, two from external projects. Another major improvement was the inclusion of global database statistics based on Achilles, a tool developed within the OHDSI initiative. Moreover, the portal is now available at a new domain name server, <https://emif-catalogue.eu>, to give higher visibility and impact to the project.

This deliverable covers these main changes and other improvements that are now implemented in the v3.0 of the Catalogue. This deliverable is aligned with D14.7, First EMIF-Platform architecture stack, where the roles of the several tools of the EMIF Platform are described. The EMIF Catalogue User Manual is presented in Annex I, and is also available online at <https://emif-catalogue.eu/documentation/>.
