Executive summary

Executive Summary

D15.6 should be viewed as an intermediary deliverable with two main focus areas. Firstly, and covering the major part of D15.6, the progress regarding the ongoing work on the business models is reported. Secondly, the Strategic Data Extension initiative is introduced. This document should be read in conjunction with D15.5. The value proposition is further refined, based on insights from interviews and workshops with users and data custodians throughout 2016. The EMIF services focus, as defined over the past few years is re-visited. An update is provided on required activities in order to complete the development of the six services by the end of 2017. Next, the business models for two separate tracks are defined, the electronic health record (EHR) track and the cohort track and a possible third alternative track is outlined. The current document, D15.6, reports the results for each of the tracks as far as was validated with all the stakeholders by the time of finalising the deliverable. Next steps are outlined in order to complete the business model development, where relevant evaluate alternatives business models and further investigate EMIF post-2017 sustainability through the introduction of potentially new "EMIF verticals".
